- Lighting will last for one evening.
- Applying to become a Mayo Clinic Lighting Partner does not guarantee approval.
- Previous acceptance as a Mayo Clinic Lighting Partner does not guarantee future approval.
- Only the official applicant/contact on the original submitted application will receive written notification stating application approval or denial.
- Lighting is only done when deemed safe by Mayo Clinic's Facilities Team.
- Lighting will only occur on the carillon tower of the Plummer Building; other Mayo Clinic buildings may not be lit.
- Signs promoting the lighting or related events are not allowed on Mayo Clinic's campus.
- Materials promoting the lighting must be approved by Mayo Clinic's Community Relations team.
